A one day workshop

Part 1: The Per Cent for Art Scheme

The Per Cent for Art Scheme is a significant commissioning fund open to artists of all disciplines – yet many artists assume that only visual artists working in three dimensional sculpture are eligible to apply. This one day workshop will assist participants examine the opportunities presented by the Per Cent for Art Scheme, help them to identify the right commissions to apply for and give examples of successful commissions in different disciplines.

Part 2: The Proposal

The second part of the day will focus on strategies for preparing a professional commission proposal – whether to the Per Cent for Art Scheme, to galleries or other commissioners. At the end of the day participants will come away with a deeper knowledge of the earning opportunities available to them through Per Cent for Art schemes, how to find out about them, and a set of strategies for how to create a compelling commissioning proposal.

This workshop will be led by **Annette Clancy**, an organisational consultant with nearly 20 years senior management experience in the arts sector. For the past 6 years she has consulted to the arts sector and her company www.inter-actions.biz assists individuals & organisations to review, evaluate and strategise.
